
CDP ORS is open and CDP deadline extended to 26 August 2020

Environmental data is a crucial lever for informed decision-making, long-term economic resilience and competitiveness. CDP, as the leading global platform for the measurement and reporting of corporate climate change information, is once again working with companies to track corporate leadership and progress towards a thriving, low carbon and resilient future.

CDP is inviting companies to participate in the 2020 cycle of climate disclosures by completing CDP's questionnaires on climate change, as a demonstration of corporate climate transparency and accountability.

Companies are required to submit their response using the CDP online platform by **26**th **August 2020** to be eligible for scoring and inclusion in reports (where applicable). A list of all the companies requested to disclose to investors in 2020 is available on the **CDP website**.

The 2020 timeline for climate disclosure is shown below:



Climate disclosure is the vital first step to drive action, helping companies to identify climate risks and to realise emerging opportunities afforded by early action and leadership. Participation in CDP Climate has the value of enabling South Africa's business community to join and contribute to the ever-increasing corporate voice on climate action and to build trust with customers and investors through transparency.
