NBI CDP LAUNCH WEEK The NBI's 2018 CDP South Africa report was launched last month in Johannesburg, Cape Town and KwaZulu-Natal with CDP data being used to track the progress by companies in South Africa in scaling up climate action and ambition. SA companies have been responding to CDP for over ten years but in 2018 we have seen a drop in CDP scores because little improvement was made to increase climate ambition and enhance target setting. Changes made to the CDP questionnaires and scoring methodologies also played a role in reducing scores in 2018. The message is clear: good governance is no longer enough to secure one's spot on the A-list; ambitious action is required.
