R1.5 TRILLION RAISED IN 5 YEARS OF SA'S WEAKEST ECONOMIC GROWTH SEEN FOR DECADES, SAYS BLSA Business Leadership South Africa (BLSA) on Monday congratulated the Presidency on a successful investment conference last week. "The fifth event was well attended and there were some powerful sessions with both business and the public sector regarding the obstacles and opportunities for greater investment. It made clear the Presidency's commitment to a conducive environment for business to invest, and there was a positive sentiment about the government's efforts to achieve that. AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK, EUROPEAN UNION, AND FRANCE INVEST \$300 MILLION IN TANZANIA'S HYDROPOWER PROJECT The government of Tanzania, the African Development Bank (www.AfDB.org), and the French Development Agency (AFD) have signed agreements for two development project loans worth \$300 million. The funds will finance the construction of the 87.8-megawatt Kakono Hydropower Plant located in Kagera region in the northern part of Tanzania. SOUTH AFRICA'S BIG ENERGY PLAN NEEDS TO ADAPT TO THE 'NEW REALITY': GORDHAN South Africa must forge its own pathway towards becoming a low carbon emissions economy, says Public Enterprises Minister Pravin Gordhan. The Minister was speaking during a panel discussion at the Presidential Climate Commission's (PCC) National Colloquium on South Africa's long-term electricity planning and the Just Energy Transition (JET). The colloquium brought together

FOR FIRST TIME, WOMEN REPRESENTED IN ALL PARLIAMENTS OF THE WORLD In this bulletin, the United Nations offers a roundup of news on gender equity progress in governments around the world. It follows the release of the Inter-Parliamentary Union's (IPU) latest report, in which it announced there are now women MPs serving in every country. The IPU also noted the increased diversity of women's participation but added that this still represented the smallest increase in six years. The organization's president, Duarte Pacheco, called on male colleagues in every parliament worldwide, "to work with their female counterparts to move forward and accelerate the pace of change". ANGLO'S 680 MW PRIORITISED FIRST-WAVE RENEWABLE ENERGY PROJECTS ON WAY Listed as a 2023 priority by Anglo American is getting the first wave of the renewable energy ecosystem projects under way in South Africa. The first wave of 680 MW renewable energy projects being undertaken by the London- and Johannesburg-listed Anglo and its partners are at various stages of development. Anglo has agreed commercial terms for two wind sites of 140 MW each, and one solar site of 200 MW in the Eastern Cape. Engineering News, 19 April 2023.

BCG AND EMIRATES NATURE-WWF HOST A WORKSHOP FOR THE UAE ALLIANCE FOR CLIMATE ACTION TO HELP DRIVE ORGANIZATIONAL CLIMATE ACTION Boston Consulting Group (BCG), one of the world's leading management consulting firms, hosted a second workshop in a collaborative series with Emirates Nature-WWF as the knowledge partner. The objective of the program is to support member-organizations within the UAE Alliance for Climate Action (UACA) through a contextual approach to net zero, outlining sector-specific net zero scenarios and highlighting requirements for emission baseline assessment. The second in the series of workshops held recently delved deeper into three key areas of climate action: an evaluation and overview of resources, scope 3 emissions, and change management. Many companies in the UAE find it challenging to account for and control scope 3 emissions, as they are not produced by the company itself but by others in their value chain. The workshop highlighted the importance of data-driven insights to help organizations reduce their overall carbon footprints. Boston Consulting Group, 14 April 2023.

TIGER BRANDS SHARES LATEST PLANT UPGRADE PLANS Fast-moving consumer goods manufacturer Tiger Brands has announced its plans to upgrade its aerosol factory with two new production lines, which will be up and running by October. The company has spent R632-million since 2016 on various facility upgrades and projects, including the installation of solar panels that currently provide 400 W of solar capacity a day for the HPC plant. In addition to using solar power at HPC, Tiger Brands also has various initiatives in place to improve energy efficiency, including using natural lighting through skylights, and water-saving initiatives through installed water tanks. Overall, the group aims to reduce its energy intensity by 30% by

2030 and its greenhouse-gas emissions by 45% by 2030, before reaching net zero by 2050. **Engineering News, 14 April 2023.**

SUN INTERNATIONAL: WINDMILL SUPPORTS THE ARTS. Art has long been a tool for cultural exchange, education and expression and Windmill Casino has made a donation to the Peter Swartz Foundation, intended to bolster development of local artists. Windmill purchased arts supplies and equipment for the Foundation worth R20 000 to benefit 42 local artists in Bloemside, Bloemfontein. The NGO, that was registered in 2017, focuses on the development of arts for learners from rural disadvantaged communities. UN ADVISORY BOARD CHARTS FRESH PATH TO BETTER GLOBAL GOVERNANCE There needs to be a major shift in global governance to better tackle such current and looming challenges as the climate crisis and rising security threats, according to a new UN report. Launched by the UN's High-Level Advisory Board on Effective Multilateralism, A Breakthrough for People and Planet: Effective and Inclusive Global Governance for Today and the Future, outlines an ambitious plan to overhaul the global architecture. Co-chaired by former President of Liberia, Ellen Johnson Sirleaf, and former Prime Minister of Sweden, Stefan Löfven, the Advisory Board was appointed by the UN Secretary-General António Guterres in 2022, tasked with advising Member States on issues of key global concern where better governance could make a difference. NEW RESEARCH FINDINGS CAN HELP DECREASE WATER USE FOR MORE SUSTAINABLE BEEF PRODUCTION A new report funded by the Water Research Commission (WRC) and undertaken by the Tshwane University of Technology (TUT), Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Resources and the Agricultural Research Council: Animal Production (ARCAP), reveals that vast volumes of water can be saved during beef production through a water-wise approach. The report, **'Sustainable application of livestock water footprints in different production systems and regions of South Africa'**, found that the cattle's frame size significantly influences the water footprint of beef production. **Engineering News, 14 April 2023.**

TEN TECHNICAL ADVISERS APPOINTED TO SUPPORT GAUTENG MUNICIPALITIES The Gauteng Provincial Treasury (GPT) has appointed ten technical advisers to be deployed across various municipalities to enhance the financial management capacity in local government. PRESIDENT APPROVES EMPLOYMENT EQUITY AMENDMENT BILL President Cyril Ramaphosa has signed into law the Employment Equity Amendment Bill of 2020, amending the Employment Equity Act with new measures to promote diversity and equality in the workplace. The amendment Bill seeks to advance transformation of South Africa's workforce by setting equity targets for economic sectors and geographical regions and requiring enterprises to develop transformation plans, the Presidency said in a statement. **Engineering News, 12 April 2023.**

DWS OUTLINES APPLICATIONS FOR HYDROPOWER GENERATION WATER USE The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) had revised its hydropower policy to enable the use of its infrastructure and water resources to generate hydropower as an alternative energy to supplement the current available electricity in South Africa and stakeholders and independent power producers (IPPs) will, from April 17, be able to submit pre-applications for water use authorisations.

There are three necessary phases of WULA application, the first of which is a pre-application phase which will be open from April 17 until June 30. The second phase will be the application compilation and submission which will end on January 31, 2024, while the third and final phase is application processing, decision and communication by the DWS, explains DWS WULA chief director Advocate Sipho Skasana. "The DWS will take a maximum period of 90 working days to process the applications. Once the decision has been made by DWS to grant a licence for hydropower generation, the licence will last for a maximum of 40 years." Engineering News, 12 April 2023.
