AFRICA CAN AND SHOULD HARNESS ITS HYDROGEN POTENTIAL FOR DEVELOPMENT Harnessing the potential for renewable energy and green hydrogen production, or replacing carbon atoms with hydrogen atoms in the energy value chain, can build peace and stability in Africa, petroleum company Conex Liberia MD Amitahb Prasad has said. "By 2035, Africa can produce 50-million tons of competitively priced green hydrogen. The expected global demand for green hydrogen is 607-million tons by 2050. In comparison, Africa's demand for green hydrogen and its derivatives is expected to reach 10-million to 18-million tons a year by 2050, but with a production potential much above that. UN SECRETARY-GENERAL BRIEFS MEMBER STATES ON PROGRESS ON OUR COMMON AGENDA Briefing Member States on progress under OCA, the Secretary-General said he was encouraged by the discussions during the SDG Summit, the Climate Ambition Summit, and other events of the UNGA High-level Week, noting that the common themes that emerged are the themes of OCA. CITY OF JOBURG OUTLINES AMBITIOUS PLANS TO MITIGATE WATER SHORTAGES Joburg Water networks senior manager Logan Munsamy on Tuesday laid out a range of plans that the municipality would undertake as it deals with critical water supply challenges across various districts. Between August and September, bulk water supplier Rand Water experienced various challenges with its infrastructure which negatively impacted the various water supply systems in the City of Johannesburg and other municipalities in Gauteng. On September 27, Water and Sanitation Minister Senzo Mchunu announced that water shifting would be implemented in some areas to deal with the water shortages in the City. WORLD HABITAT DAY FOCUSES ON CITIES AS DRIVERS OF GROWTH Priming cities to become drivers of economic growth and recovery in the aftermath of the crises such as conflict and the COVID-19 pandemic is the focus of World Habitat Day. Global economic growth is declining to about 2.5 per cent this year, the UN said. Apart from the initial COVID-19 crisis three years ago, and the global financial crisis in 2009, this represents the weakest level since 2001. Given the size of the contribution of cities to national economies, the future of many countries will be determined by their productivity. Capitalized by 37 developed countries, with voluntary additional contributions by 9 developing countries, it provides finance to developing countries towards mitigation, adaptation and resilience efforts. Its first round of funding (2015) and first replenishment (2019) both comprised roughly \$10 billion. New executive director Mafalda Duarte aims to grow the fund to \$50 billion by 2030. The Green Climate Fund plays an important role in catalysing transformational change toward a low-emissions and climate-resilient future.
