\$1BN WORLD BANK LOAN TO SUPPORT SOUTH AFRICA'S ENERGY REFORMS AND DECARBONISATION The World Bank has approved a \$1-billion development policy loan to support electricity market reforms under way in the country, as well as South Africa's low-carbon transition. As a development policy loan, the funding will be directed to the National Treasury, which immediately indicated the timing of the loan to be opportune, although no details were immediately provided regarding the loan's terms or its concessionality. UN REPORT ISSUES WAKE-UP CALL FOR ACTION ON PEACE, JUSTICE, AND INCLUSION The UN Development Programme (UNDP), the UN Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), and the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) have published an analysis of the latest data on SDG 16 (peace, justice and strong institutions) indicators. The Global Progress Report on SDG 16 Indicators warns that progress on Goal 16 "is moving in the wrong direction" and calls for action to reverse the current trend. CLIMATE FINANCE ACCELERATOR CALLS FOR CLIMATE PROJECT CAPACITY BUILDING PROPOSALS The UK government-funded technical assistance programme Climate Finance Accelerator (CFA) South Africa has launched a call for proposals to identify projects combatting climate change that would benefit from capacity-building support to help them attract investment. The accelerator is looking for projects that are at least in the prefeasibility stage and require a minimum of \$4 million. Selected projects will receive advice and support from a range of technical and financial experts to help them find investment. Engineering News, 17 October 2023.

GETTING ENDORPHINS PUMPING FOR MENTAL HEALTH Sun City Resort is raising awareness about mental health within its doorstep communities with their second annual event dedicated to getting endorphins pumping, the Sun City GM's Kasi Ride. AIR LIQUIDE RECEIVES RECOGNITION ON ITS BIODIVERSITY COMMITMENTS BY ACT4NATURE INTERNATIONAL Air Liquide's biodiversity commitments, made in 2022, have been recognized and validated by the Act4nature International initiative. This validation marks a new milestone for the Group and illustrates its attachment to biodiversity preservation and conservation. The Act4nature international initiative validated Air Liquide's commitment (a) to reinforce biodiversity assessment criteria in the investment process for all new projects by 2024; (b) to develop and implement an aggregated biodiversity indicator by 2025; (c) to raise awareness amongst employees on biodiversity and (d) to reaffirm the Group's climate and water ambitions. These commitments demonstrate the Group's recognition of the importance of biodiversity in maintaining ecological balance, preserving natural resources and ensuring the well-being of communities and wildlife. COUNCIL FOR GEOSCIENCE AND SASOL COLLABORATE TO ADVANCE CCUS RESEARCH IN SOUTH AFRICA The Council for Geoscience (CGS) and Sasol have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to collaborate, explore and develop carbon capture and utilisation and storage (CCUS) potential in South Africa. This collaboration marks another step in accelerating the trajectory towards achieving a low-carbon economy through strategic and cooperative initiatives. This agreement will leverage on the expertise and experience of both the public and private sectors and deploy CCUS research and innovation towards commercial viability and scalability in South African conditions. FLEXIBLE WORKING IS HELPING WOMEN IN WORK – BUT THEY ARE STILL STRUGGLING TO REACH SENIOR ROLES Flexible working is helping women remain in their jobs, but despite some progress, many are still struggling to reach senior roles, research suggests. A fifth of women say that flexibility has helped them keep their roles or avoid reducing their hours,

according to analysis by McKinsey and LeanIn.Org, which also found that women who work flexibly are just as committed to their careers as women in office-based roles. However, while there are more women represented in the C-suite than ever before, progress for women lower down the ranks is far slower. **World Economic Forum, 26 October 2023.**
