UK Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM):
Consultation and Comments Open Until 13 June 2024

The **National Business Initiative (NBI)** would like to inform you about the release of the **United Kingdom's Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (UK CBAM)** policy document, which is open for public comment until **13 June 2024**.

The UK CBAM aims to address carbon leakage within the United Kingdom's decarbonisation plans. The UK CBAM will work cohesively with the UK Emissions Trading Scheme (ETS), including free allowances. This is to ensure imported products are subject to a carbon price comparable to that which would have been paid if the goods were produced in the UK, thereby mitigating the risk of carbon leakage.

The sectors considered in terms of the UK CBAM include:

- Aluminium
- Iron & steel
- Cement
- Ceramics
- Fertilizers
- Glass
- Hydrogen
